

Assessment Service

We conduct a range of Assessments tailored to your individual student's needs.

Academic Assessment

An Educational Assessor will conduct a range of assessment items to provide a profile of the student's strengths and weaknesses in literacy and numeracy and will provide accommodations and modifications for home and school.

Psychometric Assessment

An Educational Psychologist will conduct a range of assessment items to provide a profile of the student's strengths and weaknesses. If the criteria is met a diagnosis will be given and modifications and accommodations will be provided for home and school.

Speech and Language Assessment

A qualified Speech Pathologist will assess receptive and expressive language skills. Practical recommendations, specific to the student's needs will be given as part of the comprehensive report.

ATAR Review

A Speld Psychologist can provide ATAR reviews if requested.

Provisional—Formal Diagnosis

When a provisional diagnosis is given, if it is then followed by 6-12 months of intensive targeted intervention, our psychologist can review and update to a formal diagnosis.

Speld Qld is a state wide organisation working with State, Catholic and Independent schools and also offering services to training organisations and workplaces.

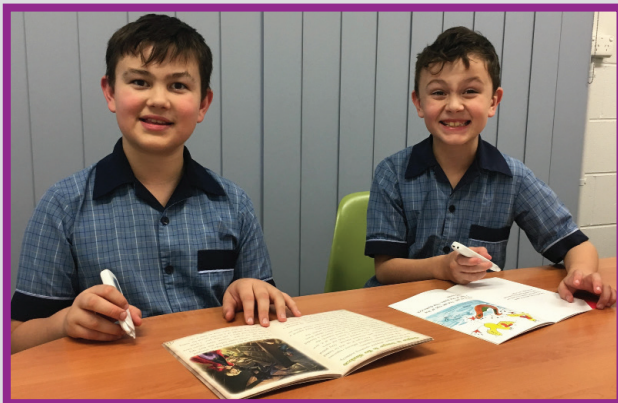

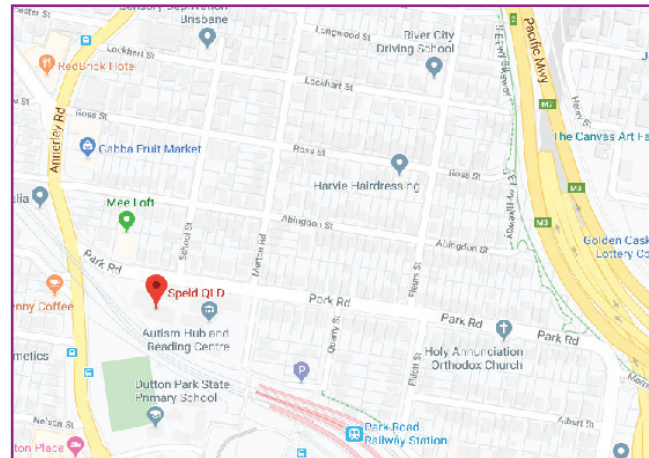
