

## Assessment Service

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We conduct a range of Assessments tailored to an individual student or adult's needs.

### Psychoeducational Assessment

A Speld Psychologist will conduct an assessment to provide a profile of the student's strengths and weaknesses. If the criteria is met a diagnosis will be given and accommodations will be provided for home and school.

### Attention Screener

Psychologists at Speld can conduct assessment to screen for challenges with attention, focus, impulsivity and/or hyperactivity.

### Academic Assessment

An Educational Assessor will conduct a range of assessment items to provide a profile of the student's strengths and weaknesses in literacy and numeracy and will provide accommodations for home and school.

### Speech and Language Assessment

A qualified Speech Pathologist will assess receptive and expressive language skills. Practical recommendations, specific to the student's needs will be given as part of the comprehensive report.

### Provisional—Formal Diagnosis

When a provisional diagnosis is given, if it is then followed by 6-12 months of intensive targeted intervention, our psychologist can review and update to a formal diagnosis.
